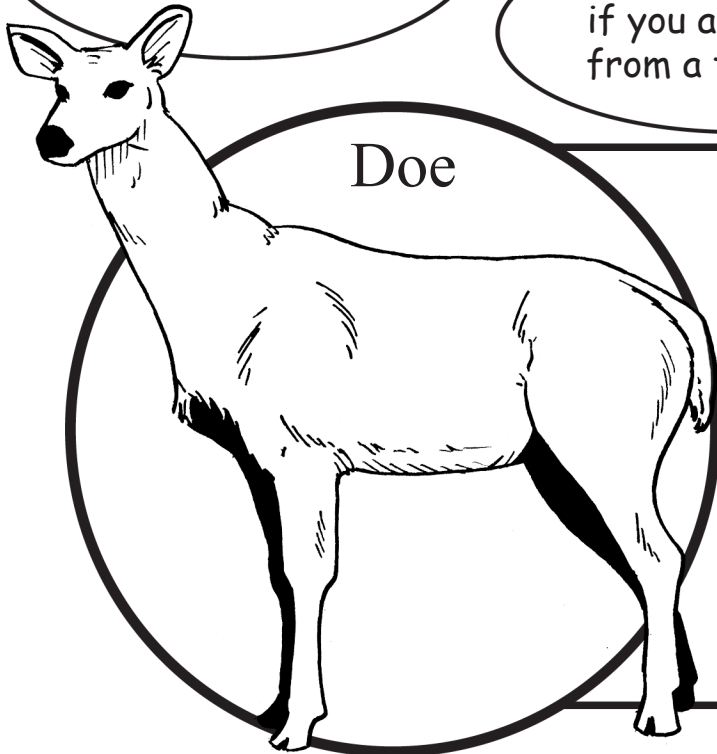
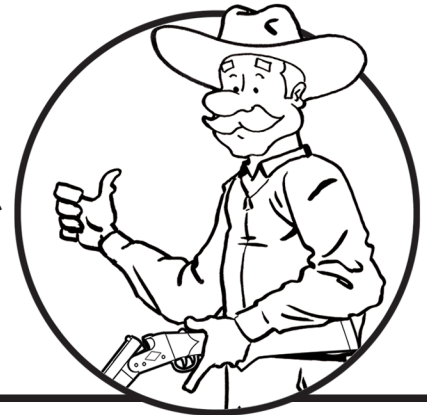


Fawn or Doe?

Does generally don't have spots.

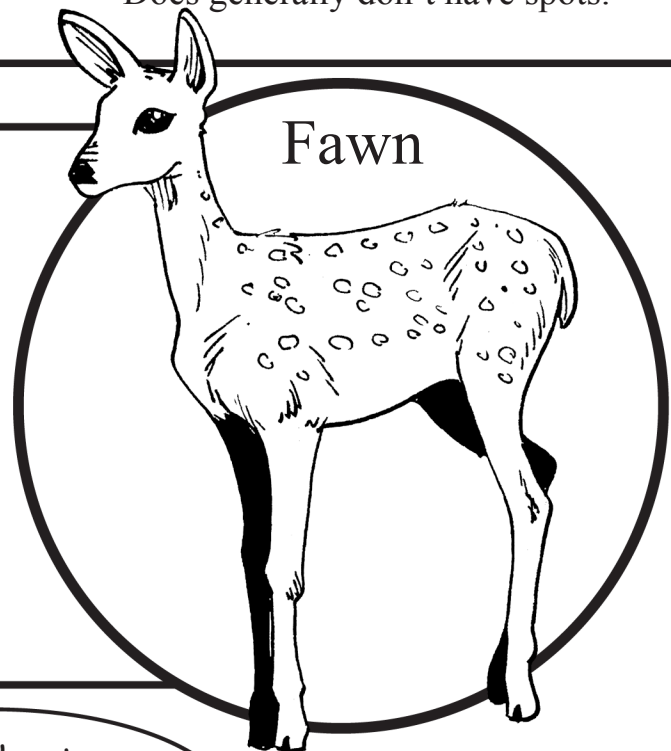
Fawns are as tall as they are long.

A fawn's eyes and ears appear large.

Male fawns often travel alone.

Fawns usually have spots.
